The ONLYWAY to get your dream garden is to get your ideas out of your head and into your landscape.

To do this you must understand how plants work together... aka DESIGN.

Garden centers are setting you up to fail.

The first secret is that garden centers are setting you up to fail. Garden centers only have a certain amount of space to sell flowers and shrubs... so they actually <u>put out</u> <u>NEW plant varieties every single week so that their stock is always in bloom</u>.

And because most gardeners don't understand what I call bloom sequencing, they head to the garden center, frenzied with spring fever buying "all the plants" in one trip. But if you do this, **two weeks later the blooms will fade** and you'll be left wondering what the heck happened or what you did wrong.

In reality, the garden center kind of screwed you. But, once you understand bloom sequencing and how to find off-season blooming plants, you can create a garden with **endless color in all four seasons**.



This garden filled with tulips and Flowering dogwoods will look amazing for a week or two in the spring.



This will be the reality for the rest of the year. Yes it's Photoshopped... But the reality will be the same.





Here are some things you can do to avoid this common issue:

- Visit the garden center multiple times a year. If your garden is not looking great, head to the garden center THAT week to find something to fill in the bloom gap.
- Create a plan ahead of time so that you buy plants that are long-blooming and give you the look you want.

So, the non-creatives can't seem to get things right even though they know tons of stuff about plants... because **they don't know how to pull it all together.** And the creatives can't seem to get things right even though they have a million awesome ideas... because they don't realize that **they need plant knowledge**, **too**.



The myth is that creativity is the solution to a beautiful garden design. But the truth is that **creativity doesn't matter all that much**. Because both creatives and noncreatives struggle with getting their dream garden (in different ways). But once you know the exact steps you need to take... It's pretty easy to make your dream garden a reality, whether you're creative or not.

I think about it like this... Instead of trying to create a masterpiece from a blank canvas, **your garden is a lot more like a paint by number**. It's really just about creating a plan and following that plan. Which is totally doable... right?






Here are some things you can do to avoid this common issue:

- If you're a creative person, you may be struggling because you have not created a plan. Try to get more organized and aligned with your garden vision.
- If you're not very creative, you may be struggling because you need a step-by-step system/plan to follow. Try to find a system that works for you so you can play "paint by number" with your landscape rather than starting from scratch.
- Accept and embrace the "weird stuff" about your property. Use these as assets that make your property special, rather than just things you dislike.

I hear all the time from people that they don't have a green thumb. Or that nothing will grow in their terrible soil... Or [insert other problem here].

But I hate to break it to you... there's no magic thumb color that makes you good or bad at gardening. And... no matter WHAT your conditions are, **there ARE plants that will grow and thrive there.** Even if your home is on a craggy mountainside with terrible soil and high gusting winds. There's actually lots of beautiful plants that will grow and thrive in those conditions. Don't believe me? Check out these beauties:



What's also cool is that plants have certain features and colors that actually tell you what types of conditions they are suited for. So once you know how to spot these characteristics, you will be able to put the right plant in the right place.

As an example... you wouldn't wear your rain slicker if you were standing in the middle of a desert, right? So... if you put a plant with a built-in rain slicker into drought-like conditions... and expect him to survive and be happy... it's really not your thumb's fault... right?





Here are some things you can do to avoid this common issue:

- Learn more about your conditions. How long does the sun hit your garden bed? Is it wet or dry? What type of soil do you have?
- Begin researching plants that ENJOY the conditions that you already have in your garden.

If a grey plant isn't getting enough sun, it will start to turn green. This will probably annoy you because you likely purchased it for it's striking, silvery tones. Worst of all, this is a sign that your plant is not happy. It can't make enough food to survive and is literally dying of hunger.







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When does the course start and finish?
